Courtroom Connect Expands Its Internet Services to Four Additional Courthouses in Orange County

Now Jurors Can Stay Productive During Service

Courtroom Connect's permanent wireless Internet network is now available at the North Justice Center courthouse; the West Justice Center courthouse; the Lameaoreux Justice Center courthouse; and the Harbor Justice Center courthouse. Jurors will now be able to connect to the wireless network during their downtime in the waiting room. Jurors can access email, surf the web, or even work remotely using laptops, handheld computers, or some Internet-enabled phones. Jurors can obtain service at daily or monthly rates.

In addition to the permanent networks available to jurors, CC will provide temporary service to law firms at trial in these locations. If a law firm notifies CC of an upcoming trial no less than four weeks beforehand, CC can set them up with any of its trial services, including remote real-time transcript streaming; printing; videoconferencing; and video, audio, and evidence streaming. Trial teams in war rooms or co-counsel in another state can watch the real-time text and video streaming of the proceedings taking place in Orange County on their computers. Remote witnesses that can't make it to trial can testify over videoconferencing. Attorneys at court can access their online repository for exhibits or send emails to trial teams using Courtroom Connect's wireless Internet. These technologies have been used on trials such as Vioxx, Sempra Energy, and In Re Walt Disney Derivative Litigation.
