In addition to booking rooms and scheduling bridging services, clients can also conduct interviews for law school recruiting, while obtaining a variety of other legal-specific services, such as court reporting and streaming. The court reporting firms that comprise the public rooms network are members of the Remote Counsel Network, formerly known as the i2i Legal Network. Since Remote Counsel Network locations offer a variety of legal-specific services, they can afford to provide room rentals at more reasonable rates. Providing room rentals for the purpose of a deposition, where services like court reporting, exhibit scanning, and legal videography are required, is much different than generic videoconferencing. Because the Remote Counsel Network is legal-specific and offers legal-specific services, room rates are much lower than one will find in the greater public room marketplace.

With one phone call, attorneys and support staff can schedule a public room for a wide range of legal events. A partner traveling out of town can call Courtroom Connect's 877-number to schedule a room to participate in a partner meeting by videoconference. Or, call the same number to schedule a public room to depose a witness located out of town or to communicate with a client based in another location.

Advanced Bridging Services

Courtroom Connect offers bridging and advanced bridging services to be used with public rooms or a client's existing videoconference equipment. Bridging, aka multipoint videoconferencing, enables multiple attorneys to take part in a "virtual conference room" for strategy sessions and monthly meetings. Dedicated ports on the videoconferencing unit are available for rent for ultimate convenience. Courtroom Connect also offers the option to record these videoconferences and stream them on-demand.

Concierge Support

Whether law firms are using public rooms or their own videoconferencing equipment, they may elect to participate in the Concierge Support plan. With the Concierge Support plan, white-glove videoconferencing IT assistance and deep discounts on an array of communication services come standard.
